

## Regional Champion

**Classification:** Part-time (10 hours per week)

**Reports To:** Director of North American Ministry

**Location:** Remote (with occasional travel as needed)

### Position Overview

Serves as the primary catalyst for a disciple-making movement within a geographic region. This role is relational, pastoral, and missional—focused on developing, equipping, and connecting pastors, men's ministry leaders, and churches around a shared commitment to discipling men in the way of Jesus.

Builds and shepherds a regional network of leaders, equipping them with No Regrets disciple-making tools and mobilizing churches to participate in the No Regrets Conference. Through intentional relationships, gatherings, and training, the Regional Champion fosters a culture of disciple-making that results in transformed lives and growing ministry impact across the region. Collaborate closely with the Ambassadors within their regional network to help deliver the No Regrets Conference to an expanding network of host sites.

### Key Responsibilities

#### **Movement and Network Development**

- Launch and steward a disciple-making movement within the assigned geographic region.
- Develop and maintain a relational network of pastors, men's leaders, and churches who meet regularly for encouragement, growth, and collaboration.
- Serve as a pastoral presence and connector for regional leaders and churches, fostering trust, friendship, and shared mission.

#### **Training and Discipleship**

- Resource regional leaders with training materials, including Disciple Maker 101, 201, and 301.
- Develop and articulate a clear discipleship pathway for men's leaders within the region.
- Host 1–2 in-person, large-group trainings annually for men and leaders in the regional network.

#### **Engagement and Gatherings**

- Develop a practical plan to meet, engage, and grow the regional network.
- Create and manage an annual rhythm of engagement, including: one-on-one leader connections, small-group leader gatherings, and larger regional gatherings or trainings.

#### **Conference and Host Site Support**

- Activate and encourage churches in the region to host the No Regrets Conference.
- Serve as a No Regrets Ambassador by overseeing regional host site relationships and coordination.
- Collaborate with the Ambassador Lead to ensure Ambassadors serving at host sites are supported and aligned, while maintaining clear role boundaries. **(Continued)**

### **Collaboration and Alignment**

- Maintain regular communication with the Director of North American Ministry.
- Collaborate proactively with the Ambassador Lead when Ambassadors are serving in the region.
- Participate in staff meetings as needed for alignment.
- Provide feedback and insights based on regional field engagement.

### **Qualifications**

- A mature follower of Jesus Christ with a passion for discipling men and the ability to clearly share their personal testimony.
- Known and respected in their community as a Jesus-follower.
- Affirms and abides by the No Regrets Statement of Faith.
- Demonstrated track record of discipling men.
- Relationally driven, mission-focused, and comfortable working independently within a broader team.
- Familiarity with church culture and men's ministry preferred.

### **Desired Outcomes**

- The Regional Champion will cultivate a thriving regional network of churches, leaders, and men who are passionate about disciple-making. This network functions as a genuine community of ministry friends—leaders who encourage and sharpen one another and partner together in discipling men.
- Through the leadership and relational investment of the Regional Champion, the region will experience a growing number of men committed to the way of Jesus, demonstrating observable life and heart transformation.
